Speaker Bio:

Johnathan Reeves is the Nursing Home Quality Improvement Specialist at the Great Plains Quality Innovation Network. Johnathan works directly with nursing home staff to implement changes to provide the best quality of care possible to Kansas elders. His experience includes work in state regulatory compliance, systems analysis, policy and procedures development, and financial analysis. Johnathan works one-on-one with nursing homes to improve quality and enhance the resident and family experience. He earned his bachelor of arts in political science from Washburn University in Topeka, Kansas and has nearly 10 years of experience in long-term care, mostly as a business office and human resources manager.

Additionally, Johnathan was selected this summer to present the Composite Calculator, a tool he developed, to top CMS staff and other leaders in Quality Improvement Organizations across the country. The Composite Calculator is now used by more than 15 states to help nursing homes examine existing data and plan future quality improvement projects. Lastly, Johnathan has worked with the Washburn University School of Nursing to develop and implement the first of its kind Quality Improvement Internship for BSN Seniors. The purpose of the internship is to partner local nursing homes with BSN seniors who have a quality improvement backgrounds and drive effective quality improvement changes locally.
